41st Annual Army Ten-Miler Will Proceed with Modifications, This Sunday, Oct. 12 to Washington, DC

The Only Packet Pick-up Location for all in-person runners is the ATM Expo's

Army Ten-Miler Race Officials are pleased to announce today that the In-Person ATM race, scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 12, 2025 in Washington, DC, will proceed. Please note full event details below regarding race weekend.

The Army Ten-Miler is being conducted in compliance with applicable guidance during the government shutdown. The race is primarily funded by Non-Appropriated Funds (NAF) generated from registration fees and sponsorships, with strict cost control measures in place to minimize reliance on appropriated resources. While indirect costs may be incurred, the event is structured to avoid additional direct costs to taxpayers.

WHAT:

The 41st Annual **Army Ten-Miler (ATM),** in Washington, DC, produced by The U.S. Army Military District of Washington (MDW). Over 28,000 runners are registered for one of the nation's premier running events, and the only race that starts and finishes at The Pentagon.

WHEN:

ATM Race Day - Sunday, Oct. 12, 2025, at 8 a.m. EDT ATM Expo - Friday, Oct. 10 & Saturday, Oct. 11. 8:30 a.m. until 8 p.m. each day

Frequency: Every hour

Last Pick-Up from Hotel: 6 p.m. Last Drop-Off at Hotel: 7 p.m.

RUNNER PACKET PICKUP:

The only ATM packet pick-up location (state issued ID and confirmation email with QR code required) is during ATM Race Expo on Friday and Saturday, 8:30 a.m. until 8 p.m.

Runner Packets contain race bibs, safety pins, runner shirts, calendar, pocket guide and a bag. Race bibs are required to get on the racecourse. Race shirts must be collected at a separate table at the ATM Expo. There is no bib pick up at the Pentagon on race day.

TRANSPORTATION:

Getting to ATM Race Day at the Pentagon - **Metrorail will open at 6 a.m. on Race Day.** Runners and spectators are advised to visit the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (<u>WMATA</u>) website when making travel plans for ATM Expo and ATM Race Day, utilizing the Trip Planner function.

The Army Ten-Miler is scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 12, 2025, at 8 a.m. EDT in Washington, DC. Conducted by The U.S. Army Military District of Washington (MDW), the Army's race is the third largest 10-mile road race in the world. The ATM starts and finishes at the Pentagon with a course that travels through Washington, DC. All race proceeds benefit U.S. Army Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation programs.
